Proposal #1: Combine the efforts of the Communications sub-committee with Education and Emerging Technologies.

Proposal #2: Replace the standing Strategic Planning and Architecture sub-committee with an ad hoc committee as it is believed that many of the topics addressed by this committee are now being addressed by the Technology Governance Board (TGB).

Proposal #3: Formalize the role of the Desktop / Workstation Administrators sub-committee and expand the role to consider printer and help desk related issues.

Proposal #4: Redefine the role of the Network Administrators Group by splitting into two groups: (1) Server Administrators Group; (2) Network Administrators Group

Proposal #5: Request that each sub-committee chair provide a draft mission statement and goals to the Council prior to the 10/25/2007 meeting.

Proposal #6: Create a new sub-committee to examine Service Oriented Architecture (SOA) activities across agencies and branches of government and report back to the committee.
